Survey conducted February 25 through February 26, 2019. 1,212 registered voters participated in the survey. Margin of Error is +/-2.81% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.

The Green New Deal proposes retrofitting every existing building in the United States to maximize energy efficiency.
